



STATEMENT OF FAITH CHRISTIAN HIT RADIO INC.

We believe:

- That the Holy Scriptures, as originally given by God, are divinely inspired, infallible, entirely trustworthy, and constitute the only supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct.
- That there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- That our Lord Jesus Christ is God manifest in the flesh; we affirm his virgin birth, sinless humanity, divine miracles, vicarious and atoning death, bodily resurrection, ascension, ongoing mediatorial work, and personal return in power and glory.
- That the salvation of lost and sinful man is through the shed blood of the Lord Jesus Christ by faith apart from works and regeneration by the Holy Spirit.
- That the Holy Spirit enables believers to live a holy life, to witness and work for the Lord Jesus Christ.
- That the Church, the body of Christ, consists of all true believers.
- That the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
- That God created marriage to be exclusively the union between one man and one woman, and that sexual intimacy is to occur exclusively within that union.
- That God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as male or female, and that these two distinct complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God.
- That gender is assigned by God at birth and the Holy Scripture does not permit an individual from altering their sexual identity physically or otherwise.
- That in order to preserve the function and integrity of CHRI as an arm of the broader Christian Church, and to provide a biblical role model to the Body of Christ and the community, it is imperative that all persons employed by CHRI in any capacity, or who serve as volunteers, agree to and abide by Biblical teachings on Marriage, Gender, and Sexuality.
- That every person must be afforded compassion, love, kindness, respect, and dignity and that hateful and harassing behaviour or attitudes directed toward any individual are to be repudiated and are not in accord with Scripture nor the doctrines of the Church.
